*Social-Political Values of Young People in Lithuania:
Selfish Utilitarianism and Civic Activities*

The main thesis of this article is that civic and political activity of older generations of Lithuanian population is based on “sense of duty” and traditional moral values (importance of family, patriotism, religion) while younger generation is characterized by secular-rational values (priority is given to measures of personal benefit, efficiency). It is argued in the article that this intergenerational difference in value orientations is more important than life cycle effect explaining differences of political and civic engagement between young and older people in Lithuanian society.

*Value profile of public servant in the context
of contemporary Lithuanian political culture*

Value orientations of Lithuanian civil servants are analyzed in the context of political culture of society. After the short summing-up on Lithuanian political culture research author concentrates on such features of political culture as distrust in authorities, public institutions, state and democracy; negative attitude towards legislation and attempts to drive through using

informal rules and networks; inability to envisage difference between private and public. The role model of civil servant prescribed by Lithuanian legislation reflect the striving, meanwhile in reality officials' practiced values correspond with the orientations of consuming society and some negative habits and stereotypes inherited from the soviet times.

*The Relationship between Politicians and Bureaucrats:
Early Approaches*

The article compares W. Wilson's, M. Weber's and J. Schumpeter's approaches towards the role of politicians and bureaucrats. W. Wilson proposed to separate politics and administration, while M. Weber considered that bureaucracy should be subordinated to the will of political leaders and J. Schumpeter argued that professional bureaucracy should be sufficiently strong to advise and even to direct politicians. The twofold explanation is provided to explain this divergence of approaches. First, it could be explained by the variety of parliamentary systems, related to the different executive-legislative linkage, ranging from the British-type of premiership of cabinet system to the French type of assembly government. Second, it could be explained by the aims of democratic societies to have both political responsive and professionally responsible bureaucracy.

*The funding of political parties in Lithuania:
the search for the most suitable model*

This article deals with the present mechanism of political parties funding in Lithuania. Although the legislator of Lithuania has passed laws that should have influence on prevention of corruption in politics, but the results

of quantitative and qualitative researches show that the rules concerned with funding of parties are not enough effective *de facto*. In this article author analyzes in detail the particularities of private and public funding models of political parties and expand the concept that in a modern democracy it is necessary not to choose one of those patterns, but try to combine them effectively. The author concludes that the main obstacle for the transparent funding of political parties in Lithuania is “the corrupted mentality” which regulations are not able to surmount yet.
